

NOTICE OF ADOPTION OF ORDINANCE
TOWNSHIP OF LAKETOWN, ALLEGAN COUNTY, MICHIGAN

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that at its April 12, 2023 meeting, the Board of Laketown Township adopted Ordinance No. 206, the State Construction Code with Floodplain Management Provisions Ordinance (the "Ordinance"). The following provides a summary of the Ordinance. This Notice and the summary are intended to meet the publication requirements contained in Michigan law. The Ordinance shall be effective 30 days after publication.

ORDINANCE NO. 206

STATE CONSTRUCTION CODE FLOODPLAIN
MANAGEMENT PROVISIONS ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE TO DESIGNATE AN ENFORCING AGENCY TO DISCHARGE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE TOWNSHIP OF LAKETOWN LOCATED IN ALLEGAN COUNTY, AND TO DESIGNATE REGULATED FLOOD HAZARD AREAS UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THE STATE CONSTRUCTION CODE ACT, ACT NO. 230 OF THE PUBLIC ACTS OF 1972, AS AMENDED, ALL BY RESTATING ARTICLE II OF CHAPTER 10 OF THE LAKETOWN TOWNSHIP CODE OF ORDINANCES.

Section 1 of the Ordinance restates Article II, Chapter 10 of the Laketown Township Code of Ordinances.

Sec. 10-19 designates the Township Building Inspector to enforce Act 230.

Sec. 10-20 states Appendix G of the Michigan Building Code shall be enforced.

Sec. 10-21 designates the regulated flood prone hazard areas.

Sec. 10-22 addresses the enforceability of more restrictive standards.

Section 2 of the Ordinance addresses publication and effective date.
